Sermon date: March 13, 2022

Sermon Title: Prime Directive 4 – Introducing People to Jesus Scripture: 2 Timothy 2:20-21, 1 Peter 3:15-16, Acts 1:4-8

Connection:

1) What do you remember most from last week's sermon?

- 2) How did you hear God's voice or sense His presence this past week?
- 3) What are you thankful for this week?

Reflection:

- 1) Summarize the sermon in one to three sentences. What was the main point of the message?
- 2) What did the message say about you, God's people or the world?
- 3) What did that message mean for our church?

Application

- 1) Last week Pastor Randy discussed how to be a disciple? How were you a disciple of Jesus this past week?
- 2) The second prime directive is loving our neighbors as ourselves. Who is God calling you to love this week? How can you share the Gospel with that person(s)?
- 3) Re-read 2 Timothy 2:20-21. How can we be like the special utensil? What might that look like?
- 4) Re-read 1 Peter 3:15-16 and Acts 1:4-8. What do you see in these passages?
- 5) What did you hear in the wire cutter story? How can we stay sharp as tools for God to use to introduce Jesus to others?
- 6) Pastor Randy described concentric circles. The center was 1) Engaged, moving outward to 2) Very supportive of church ministry, 3) Riding the Wave and 4) Watching. Reflect on where you are in these circles. In addition to prayer, how can we encourage and lead others to move to the center?
- 7) Pastor Randy described the need to have a one minute story of your salvation and love of Jesus. Can you share that with the group right now? Take a few minutes to organize your thoughts and practice sharing it with others.

8) End by praying together for Jesus to be known in our city, country and world. Pray for New Horizons to be a lighthouse in Spokane, and for the Pathways project.
