- 2) Re-read verse 13. What does it mean to be content in Jesus? How can we live that out this week?
- 3) Pastor Ryan said "you choose to be content, it is not something that happens to you." How could you live that out this week?
- 4) How could we better serve our friends inside the church?
- 5) How can we go beyond being "friendly enough" to being "real friends" in this church? What might we do this week to deepen Christian friendships at NHCC?
