Connection:

- 1) What do you remember most from last week's sermon?
- 2) How did you hear God's voice or sense His presence this past week?
- 3) What are you thankful for this week?

Reflection:

- 1) Summarize this week's sermon in one to three sentences. What was the main point of the message?
- 2) What did the message say about you, God's people or the world?

Application

- 1) What did Brian mean by saying "I am Nineveh? Read Romans 3:10-18 and 3:23 for more context.
- 2) What did Jonah 4 say about Jonah's heart? Why would he wait around to see what happened to Nineveh?
- 3) Who is your Nineveh? Who do you need to love and pray for more?
- 4) What did Brian mean by saying "I am Jonah?" Where do you need to be more grateful and less petty?
- 5) Have you ever been unhappy when God showed grace on others? What can you do about such reactions?
- 6) End by praying **together** to fully know Christ in light of this teaching. Pray for New Horizons to be a lighthouse in Spokane, and for the Pathways project.
