Connection:

- 1) What do you remember most from last week's sermon?
- 2) How did you hear God's voice or sense His presence this past week?
- 3) What are you hopeful for in 2023?

Reflection:

- 1) Summarize this week's sermon in one to three sentences. What was the main point of the message?
- 2) What did the message say about you, God's people or the world?

Application

- 1) How do you plan? Or how do you keep track of time? What is working or not working for you in your approach?
- 2) What do you wish you had more time for? What prevents you from having that time?
- 3) Read Psalms 90:12, 40:1 and 46:10. What do you see in these verses? How can we live differently this week?
- 4) Re-read Matthew 25:1-13. What else do you learn about time from this passage?
- 5) If time is a gift, how do we need to receive it? How do we need to give it?
- 6) End by praying **together** for our church to use time in a Godly fashion in 2023. Pray for New Horizons to be a lighthouse in Spokane, and draw others to Him this new year.
