- 2- What stood out to you?

- 4- How does this message apply in your life?

Application and Challenge

- 1- How do you see favoritism in your world?
- 2- How are you practicing awareness of what’s happening in the world and how favoritism could be creeping in?
- 3- Read John 15:18. Christian values are inherently *not of this world* and are by nature historically offensive to culture. How can you describe your faith as *not of this world*?
- 4- How do you navigate Christian values with worldly expectations? Has it “cost” you anything? Do you think Christian values should or shouldn’t come at a “cost”?
- 5- How do you prioritize Jesus and faith over world events and preferences?
