9.Who are other persons you know of who are or were "ordinary people doing extraordinary things?" (Any examples from Scripture and in the world today?) What can we learn from those persons and their character? 10.Why is Pastor Randy looking for people who are "willing, weak, and will allow God to use what we can bring to the table?"Why those three traits? And how can God use each of those traits this month in the kingdom?
