- •How can you pursue what is good this week?

- •Last week Pastor Randy asked "how are you willing to let God use what you have to bring to the table?" How do we answer that question today?
- •End by praying together for Jesus to be known in our city, country and world. Pray for New Horizons to be a lighthouse in Spokane especially during this Christmas season.
