



Sermon Title: “When Pigs Fly - Miracles of Healing – Pastor Randy
Scripture Reference: Mark 5:21-43

Connection:

- What do you remember most from last week’s sermon?
- How did you hear God’s voice or sense His presence this past week?
- What are you thankful for this week?

Reflection:

- Summarize the sermon in one to three sentences. What was the main point of the message?
- What did the message say about you, God’s people or the world?
- What did that message mean for our church?

Application

- Share a story of God’s healing in your life. Was that also a miracle?
- What stood out to you the most in Greg and Autumn’s story?
- How do you reconcile Randy’s story of his brother Doug being healed from blindness and his friend Harry not being healed from a tumor? And read 2 Corinthians 12:5-10. How do we handle God not healing us or someone when we ask?
- What does Randy mean here: “Our faith is not based on the miracles of God, our faith is based on the miraculous God?”
- Re-read Mark 5:21-43. What does Jairus and the woman subject to bleeding have in common? What does Jesus say to each of them, and why is that important?
- Re-read Hebrews 11:1. What does this verse mean?
- Read 1 Timothy 5:23, 2 Timothy 4:20 and 2 Corinthians 12:7-10. What miracles are mentioned here?

- Personal reflection question: How will I live out this teaching in the week to come?
- End by praying together for Jesus to be known in our city, country and world. Pray for New Horizons to be a lighthouse in Spokane, and for the Pathways project. And pray for Greg's vocal cord to be fully healed.
