Connection:

Reflection:

- Summarize the sermon in one to three sentences. What was the main point of the message?

- What did that message mean for our church?

Application

- Pastor Randy asked “what is it that keeps me from loving others as much as I love myself.” How would you answer that question?
- Re-read Luke 10:25-37. What do you learn about the priest and the Levite? Who are the Samaritans in Spokane? How can we love those Samaritans?
- Read 1 John 4:7-12. What does God’s law command us to do? How have you lived this passage?
- What is the difference between being nice, and loving with the love of Jesus? How would you explain the difference between the two to others?
- But what if you do not want to love, or love a person whom you do not like? You know what God calls us to do. What keeps us from loving the unlovely?
- Read John 15:34. What does it look like to live this out in the coming week?

- What is the relationship between mercy and love? How might we demonstrate both at church? Outside of church?
- Personal reflection question: How will I live out the teaching in the week to come?
- End by praying together for Jesus to be known in our city, country and world. Pray for New Horizons to be a lighthouse in Spokane.
