

Sermon Title: A Loving God - The Exclusive God - Pastor Ryan Scripture Reference: Romans 3:9-12, John 3:16-21

Connection:

- How did you hear God's voice or sense His presence this past week?
- What are you thankful for this week?

Reflection:

- Re read John 3:16-21 and read John 14:1-7. What do these passages say about salvation? What do you learn about God's love here?

- What is the connection of Romans 1:18-20 to the claims of God's exclusive love in Christ?
- Personal reflection question: How will I live out this teaching in the week to come?
