Sermon date: March 6, 2022

Sermon Title: Prime Directive 3 – Becoming More Like Jesus

Scripture: John 13:34-35, Acts 1:4-8, Matthew 28:18-20

Connection:

- 1) What do you remember most from last week's sermon?
- 2) How did you hear God's voice or sense His presence this past week?
- 3) What are you thankful for this week?

Reflection:

- 1) Summarize the sermon in one to three sentences. What was the main point of the message?
- 2) What did the message say about you, God's people or the world?
- 3) What did that message mean for our church?

Application

- 1) What does it mean to be a disciple? Where do you hear the word in a spiritual context? Non-spiritual context?
- 2) Describe good examples of lordship and discipleship. Where have you seen these good examples in your life or the lives of others? What hinders you from giving Jesus total control of life?
- 3) How do you struggle in loving your neighbors? What hinders you from loving them and being Christ to them? Who is God calling you to love specifically?
- 4) Read John 3:3-5. What does it mean to be born-again?
- 5) Read Philippians 3:17-21. What does this passage say about discipleship for us today?
- 6) Why is Pastor Randy praying for a "season of struggle?" What hoped outcome might come from that?
- 7) Pastor Randy concluded by describing a need to read scripture, journal about it and pray about it, and to meet with others for "iron sharpening iron." What might that look like for us this week if we did that?
- 8) End by praying **together** for Jesus to be known in our city, country and world. Pray for New Horizons to be a lighthouse in Spokane, and for the Pathways project.
