Scripture: Philippians 4:8-9

Connection:

- 1) What do you remember most from last week's sermon?
- 2) How did you hear God's voice or sense His presence this past week?
- 3) What are you thankful for this week?

Reflection:

- 1) Summarize this week's sermon in one to three sentences. What was the main point of the message?
- 2) What did the message say about you, God's people or the world?
- 3) Reflect back on the summer series in Philippians. What key teachings stand out to you?

Application

- 1) Re-read the verses Pastor Randy quickly highlighted: 1:6, 1:9, 1:21, 2:1, 2:9-12 and 4:4-5. What makes these verses stand out to you?
- 2) Read verse 4:8 and note the eight items in the verse. (Take each one of these at a time). What does it look like for us individually and collectively to think about what is true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent, praiseworthy?
- 3) Read verse 9. What is the relationship between putting these items into practice and the peace of God?
- 4) End by praying **together** to fully know Christ in light of this teaching. Pray for New Horizons to be a lighthouse in Spokane, and for the Pathways project.
