

Sermon Title: Worldly Wealth- Pastor Ryan McClelland Scripture Reference: Luke 16:1-15, Mark 10:17-22

## **Connection:**

## Reflection:

- Summarize this week's sermon in one to three sentences. What was the main point of the message?
- What did the message say about you, God's people or the world?
- Reflect back on the summer series in Philippians. What key teachings stand out to you?

## **Application**

- Re-read Luke 16:1-15. What did Ryan mean by saying "you are to use your money as a tool to win people to the Lord until the wealth fails?" What would that look like for us today?
- Re-read Mark 10:17-22. What does the passage tell us about discipleship?
- Read Luke12:33-34. What does that passage say about discipleship? How might we live that out this week?
- Read Luke 14:25-26. Pastor Ryan said Jesus must be the pre-eminent relationship in our lives. How do we live that out on a daily basis?
- Read John 6:53-66. What do we do with the hard teachings of Jesus? Do we follow them?
- Reflect on what Ryan's call for us to give "somewhere between everything you own and an amount that is making you count on God

because Jesus is your master and not your money." How can we live this out?

• End by praying together to fully know Christ in light of this teaching. Pray for New Horizons to be a lighthouse in Spokane, and for the Pathways project.
