- 2- What is the “Real Christmas” story? What are some things that distract us from the real story?
- 3- What makes the story of Mary and the Angel in Luke 1 so special? What stood out to you about why this conception is unique and important?
- 4- How does God’s plan interfere with your preferences? Are you stepping into submission or disobedience to God’s plan for your life?
- 5- How can we change our perspective of Christmas from a time about “us” to a time about Jesus?
