Scripture Reference: Luke 11:43

Connect: Grow together

- 1- How has God shown up this week in your life?
- 2- What can you be thankful for this week? Any stressors?
- 3- How are you doing on your spiritual or personal growth? Did you gain any ground last week?

Deeper: Beyond the message

- 1- What was the main point of the message this week? How would you say it?
- 2- What stood out to you?
- 3- What did the message say about you, God’s people or the world?
- 4- How does this message apply in your life?

Application and Challenge

- 1- Read Luke 11:37-53. Where do you see the type of pride discussed during the message show up in this conversation?
- 2- How as Christians can we be representatives of Christ that help lead people towards Jesus and not away from him?
- 3- Do you have people in your life you can reach out to that will give you loving, honest insight on the fruits you’re producing?
- 4- Between security and significance, which one resonates with you most?
(Often a blend of both yet common to lean one way of the other)
- 5- What things can you let go of that are keeping you from the most significant responsibility *(Matt 28:18-19, Matt 22:37-40)* and the most secure position *(John 3:16, Romans 10:9)* that Jesus provides for us?
